

PA FROM THE COCKPIT

Applicable to: ALL

PERFORMING A PA FROM THE COCKPIT HANDSET

The flight crew can use the cockpit handset to perform a PA. The operation of the cockpit handset is identical to the cabin handsets.

Note: As a standard, it is possible to perform a PA to FCRC only from the cockpit handset. The cabin handsets do not allow to perform a PA in the FCRC.

L2 PERFORMING A PA FROM THE COCKPIT RMP

The flight crew can also use alternative equipment and panels to perform a PA: the RMP, in conjunction with the hand mike, the boomset or the oxygen mask.

L1 MONITORING A CABIN PA IN THE COCKPIT

When a PA is performed in cabin, the flight crew can listen to this PA via the Handset or the RMP and the Audio Equipment (e.g. boomset, oxygen mask...).

L2 This function enables the flight crew to check if they might interrupt an ongoing PA, when performing a PA from the cockpit.
